Remote ID Module – The two recommended modules are Spektrum Sky ID and Holy Stone. Victor Dumet gave a demonstration after the meeting. Both remote ID modules use Bluetooth 5 with long range, which means it reaches 1 kilometer or 3,280 ft. All modules must be registered with the FAA.
